

## Books:

Each year the KidsExchange Consignment Sale tries to improve on its service to the community. In keeping with that desire, additional categories have been added to the Book Room after polling customers, teachers, homeschool families, and librarians.

As you are packing up your books to bring to the Sale, go ahead and put them in these categories ([see list of categories at end](#)) to make it easier to drop off and display them at the KidsExchange Consignment Sale. **Just as sellers organize their clothes, toys, and other items to display them, organizing books into the appropriate categories allows them to be better seen and purchased.**

**When dropping off your books, place your books in their appropriate locations, with the title showing, displayed in boxes provided (see sample photograph).** Our goal is to make it easier for sellers' books to be displayed, so customers will be able to find the types of books they are seeking. **When the books are easy to find, more customers will buy more books, which means more of your books are SOLD = more cash in your pocket!**

Sellers, **if you are bringing ten or more books to the sale**, please bring them in a cardboard box. Once you arrive at the Book Room, you will place each book in the correct category. Then leave your box in the Book Room under any of the tables, so it can be used to display additional books. **Any boxes you might have left from bringing any of your other items to the sale, feel free to put them under the tables in the Book Room; sellers can use them to display additional books.**

**NOTE:** the tables in the center of the Book Room will feature "Homeschool/Educational" resources, divided into subjects. This room is also where physical school supplies (example: notebooks, desk organizational items, etc) will be housed for this sale.

## Games:

Sellers, when placing your games on the display tables, please place them upright on one side, with the title of the game facing up (see sample photo) Not only will it make it easy to see the title of the game, it will allow more games to be displayed in the space allotted for them, it will keep the area neat, which will attract more customers to see and purchase your items—a win-win for sellers and customers alike!


**Be sure to tape up the edges of the game boxes, so no pieces will be lost.**



## Puzzles:

Sellers, when placing your puzzles to display, please place them in the appropriate category (24 pieces; 25-150 pieces; 200-500 pieces; or more than 500 pieces), with the box turned on edge, so the title of the puzzle can be seen (see sample photo). **Placing them upright allows more puzzles to be placed on the tables, makes them easier for customers to see them and purchase them = more cash for your pocket!!**  
**Be sure to tape up the puzzle boxes/containers, so no pieces will be lost.**

If you have **flat preschool type puzzles**, be sure to secure the pieces by either wrapping them in plastic wrap & taping the 'package' securely or enclosing them in a ziplock bag, taping the bag shut. **Place the flat preschool type puzzles in a display box on their sides similar to file folders in a file box, so buyers can easily flip through them.**
